JUROR Lawrence (Larry) Rudolech

A native of Madison, Indiana Larry Rudolech has spent most of his life admiring and studying the simple and natural beauty of southern Indiana's countryside. He attended the John Herron School of Art in Indianapolis. Larry has worked in all facets of commercial art and ran his own freelance design and illustration company until the end of 2007. He renewed his fine art career in the late 1990s. In 2001, Larry was accepted into his first Hoosier Salon Show. His work has been accepted every year since. His subject matter is normally anything found in everyday life, so he does not feel a need to paint every detail. He gives viewers just enough so we can finish the painting with the mind's eye. After all, he is not really dealing with what is in the painting as much as he is with the emotions he is feeling at the time he is painting it. Larry has accomplished a great deal as a full-time fine artist winning awards in both local and national shows as well as many awards in Plein Air events around the country. In the last two years Larry has been awarded signature status in both the American Impressionist Society and the National Oil & Acrylic Painters' Society.

SPECIFICATIONS

Artists may enter a maximum of three works for one entry fee. The work must have been completed in the past two years and not accepted previously for any juried exhibition at Minnetrista. No entry may exceed 60 inches in any direction and 100 pounds in weight. All two-dimensional entries must be properly framed and ready to hang (no saw tooth hangers or clips). Paint must be dry. A single entry may contain no more than four component parts.

ELIGIBILITY

Any artist 18 years of age or older who is a present or former resident of Indiana.

Professional Division:

Anyone who earns \$4,000 or more per year in art sales, commissions or prize money, or who teaches art.

Avocational Division:

Anyone who earns less than \$4,000 per year in art sales, commission or prize money, or who does not teach art.

Eligible Work includes:

Paintings, Drawings, Mixed Media, Prints, Sculpture, Fiber, Metalwork, Ceramics, and Photography.

Video art is not eligible.

ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

Professional Division:

- Submit digital images on a CD or flash drive—300 dpi; jpeg or tiff format; CMYK; largest dimension must be 7 inches. CDs and flash drives will not be returned.
- Name the digital file as follows: last name first initial title of work entry #.jpg (example: vincent k self portrait 1.jpg).
- Mail or deliver the entry form, CD or flash drive, and \$35 entry fee to be received by 5 p.m. Monday, January 14, 2019.

Avocational Division:

- **Again this year:**
Avocational artists may enter one of two ways: (1) digitally or (2) by bringing artwork in for jurying for the full price entry fee of \$35. If you enter digitally, you will receive a \$10 discount on the entry fee, making it \$25.
- **To Enter Digitally:**
 - Submit digital images on a CD or flash drive—300 dpi; jpeg or tiff format; CMYK; largest dimension must be 7 inches. CDs and flash drives will not be returned.
 - Name the digital file as follows: last name first initial title of work entry #.jpg (example: vincent k self portrait 1.jpg).
 - Mail or deliver the entry form, CD or flash drive, and \$25 entry fee to be received by 5 p.m. Monday, January 14, 2019.
- **To Enter By Bringing In Artwork**
 - Bring artwork, entry form, and \$35 entry fee to Minnetrista on Friday, February 8, 2019, from 1 p.m.–5 p.m. or Saturday, February 9, 2019, from 10 a.m.–5 p.m. The artist's name and title of the piece must be attached to the back of the artwork.

PAYMENT

Payment of the entry fee may be made by cash, check or money order (payable to Minnetrista), cash or Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover.

NOTIFICATION

Professional Division and Avocational Division (image entries):

- Notification will be emailed and/or mailed no later than Monday, February 4, 2019.

Avocational Division (drop-off entries):

- Notification will be emailed and/or mailed no later than Friday, February 15, 2019.

AWARDS

Approximately \$2,500 in prizes will be awarded. Purchase awards may also be given.

AWARDS RECEPTION & DATES OF EXHIBIT

All entrants and their guests are invited to attend the opening reception on Friday, February 22, 2019, from 5:30–7:30 p.m. Awards will be presented at approximately 6:15 p.m. The exhibit will be open to the public February 23–April 28, 2019.

SALES

All artists are encouraged to offer their artwork for sale. Minnetrista is solely responsible for all sales and will retain 40% of the selling price of each work sold. Artwork sold may not be removed from the show until Monday, April 29, 2019.

AGREEMENT

Submission of artwork shall be understood to indicate agreement to abide by the rules and the decision of the juror. Minnetrista may photograph the artwork and use the images in publications, advertisements or promotional materials. Artwork may not be withdrawn prior to the close of the exhibit.

INSURANCE

All accepted works will be insured while at Minnetrista at a value agreeable to the artist and to Minnetrista. Minnetrista will not be responsible for insuring unclaimed artwork after Monday, July 1, 2019.

RETURN OF ARTWORK

Artwork is to be picked up on Monday, April 29, 2019, between 10 a.m.–6 p.m. Artwork not picked up by Friday, July 1, 2019, becomes Minnetrista's property unless prior arrangements have been made.
